## U10 to U11 Transition

Hello Parents and Coaches,

Your U10 players will advance to U11 soccer next fall and continue in our Academy Program. The following list will hopefully answer your questions about next year.

### Team Format:

**Competitive Teams-** Teams will be formed at the Player Placements on June 1<sup>st</sup>. Competitive soccer involves U11-U18 teams. Players compete within their age groups and participate in **Colorado Youth Soccer** leagues involving front-range travel. The players compete in 18-20 games during the fall and spring seasons for the U11-U14 age groups. The CYS leagues represent the highest levels of competition. The teams are trained by licensed paid coaches 2-3 times per week with games on Saturday. Competitive teams participate in 2-4 tournaments per year.

\* These fees are for the 2009/2010 year, the fees include Colorado Fusion fees, CYS fees, referee fees, field fees and coaches' fees for **both fall and spring**. Indoor fees, tournament fees and expenses, uniforms or other team expenses are not included. Required uniform cost is approximately \$275. When you commit to a Colorado Fusion team, you are committing for two full seasons, fall and spring. These fees are subject to change.

### **Option I Teams:**

1. This is a front-range league where you will play developmental teams from the front-range area. This league has Gold and Silver flights and schedules ten games per season. Participation in this league requires club approval and travel to five away games.
2. \$195.00\* for the year (Fall/Spring)
3. \$150.00\* for a single season
4. \$50.00\* for the mandatory club uniform (available at Soccer Stop)
5. \$350.00\* for the year playing on teams (includes Adidas Predator Program and club registration)
6. Train 2 times a week for 90 minutes.

**Inter-league Teams:**

They will play in the Inter-league division which is a Metro Denver travel league.

Teams will be playing 11v11, rosters consist of 14-18 players.

They will play 16 league games per year.

\$150.00\* for a single season

\$50.00\* for the mandatory club uniform (available at Soccer Stop)

2 training sessions per week for 90 minutes will be offered.

**8v8 In-House Teams:**

These may be teams that don't have enough players to go 11v11 and would like to stay in the Fusion In-House League. They will play 8v8 and have 10-12 players on the roster.

They will play 16 league games per year

\$195.00\* for the year (Fall/Spring)

\$150.00\* for a single season

\$50.00\* for the mandatory club uniform (available at Soccer Stop)

2 training sessions per week for 90 minutes will be offered.

**Coaches:**

**Advanced** team coaches are licensed paid coaches.

**Developmental** team coaches are volunteer coaches.

We have coaching clinics for both Advanced and Developmental coaches.

**Previous Playing experience:****Advanced team placement:**

Players are placed on teams based on ability. Technical skills, athleticism, movement off the ball, work rate and level of interest in the game of soccer are some important criteria used to evaluate players.

The number of teams formed depends on the number of qualified players and committed parents. The typical roster size can be anywhere from 14 to 17 players. The number of players trying out usually exceeds the number of available roster spots. In case your child is not being offered a spot on a competitive team, we will make every effort to find a spot for your child on one of our in-house developmental, inter-league or intermediate Option 1 teams.
